

WAGE INDEMNITY

SERVICE CANADA REPORTING REQUIREMENT FOR PAYMENTS

The following print screens provide an example/guidance on where to find the required report to accompany your Wage Indemnity claim.

- Go to your *My Latest Claim* Page on your My Service Canada account
- Service Canada's site does not state "Sickness Benefits" beside Type of Benefit, but the Welfare Office needs confirmation that you are receiving Sickness Benefits. Go to the next steps...

- Click on the "Last Report Processed" dates which should be underlined and in blue. This should take you to that week's detailed payment report
- The opened page should confirm "Sickness Benefits".
- Send a copy of the My Latest Claim and the My Payment Details report to the Welfare office along with the additional required forms.

- to prevent any delays, you must complete your report within three weeks of its due date.

You will stop receiving benefits once one of the following 2 conditions has occurred:

- All the weeks of benefits to which you were entitled to have been paid. This occurs when the number of weeks displayed in the "Weeks of Regular Benefits Paid" row is equal to the number of weeks displayed in the "Total Weeks of Regular Entitlement".
- OR
- The "End Date of Claim" has been reached.
