

Children's Orthodontics

How to begin receiving the Children's Orthodontics Benefit:

- 1. Submit a treatment plan to info@213benefits.org prior to commencement of treatment
 - The treatment plan must include:
 - Name and birthdate of dependent
 - Expected duration of treatment
 - o Breakdown of total fees to be incurred (initial payment, monthly fees)
 - o Coordination of Benefits if any other plan will be paying (i.e. spouse's plan
 - Once the treatment plan is approved, a confirmation letter will be issued to the member
 of the amount that will be reimbursed based on the treatment plan.

Once approved:

- The plan will pay up to 75% of the treatment cost to a limit of \$7,000 for a total payable amount of \$5,250 per child per lifetime. The member must advise if any other plan is involved and provide a Coordination of Benefits.
- The plan will only reimburse the member in monthly instalments. We do not pay dental/orthodontic clinics directly, and treatment costs will not be reimbursed in a lump sum.
- The coverage will cease immediately if the member is no longer covered by Plan A.

Submitting for reimbursement:

Submit your **paid receipt** along with a <u>Children's Orthodontics Reimbursement Slip</u> which can be found on our website at 213pension.org.

 Please note: proof of payment must be provided with each submission (paid receipt, redacted bank statement).
